"AROUND THE BUOYS"

Division 1 Start 1315hrs

A race around the buoys in the vicinity of Queenscliff Harbour, Queenscliff Pier & Shortlands Bluff

"RACE THE FERRY"

Sternchaser format from a start at the Popes Eye annulus at not earlier than 1520hrs to a mark off Queenscliff Harbour

"COMMUNITY BEACH ACTIVITIES"

An opportunity for those not sailing to participate in a range of beach activities including the Queenscliff Herald's "Benito's Treasure Hunt", camel rides, beach sports, sausage sizzle, etc from 1400hrs on Queenscliff foreshore and in Lower Princes Park

"BLACK CROW CHASE"

Sternchaser format from a start of Queenscliff Pier into Lonsdale Bight and return
First start at 1100hrs

"HARBOUR ACTIVITIES"

An opportunity for those not sailing to participate in a range of activities in Queenscliff Harbour including fishing clinic family fishing competition and learn to dive

ELIGIBILITY: Trailable Yachts (as defined by the AYF) with a current VYC Class Basic Handicap, Coutu Boats with a current handicap issued by the Coutu Boat Club, keel boats with a current club handicap acceptable to the Race Committee.

The Crew shall consist of at least one adult and another person of minimum age of 14 years.
Teams of three boats are encouraged to enter as a team
